

# **Competition Rules & Guidelines**

## **Images**

- 1. Each club may submit up to three (3) images for each of the seven (7) prescribed subjects up to 21 images per club.
- 2. The maximum allowed images per maker depends on club size:

Club Membership	Maximum Images per person
14 or fewer	11
15-21	7
22-26	5
27-34	4
35-48	3
More than 48	2

- 3. The Non-A Grade Open subject is for club AB and B grade photographers only. Clubs where members are un-graded may submit three images by novice members.
- 4. Should a person belong to more than one QLD camera club, they may submit entries via one club only.
- 5. Images submitted in a previous QLD Interclub competition may <u>not</u> be entered in this competition.
- 6. Competition entries will be displayed via a projector and will be 'impact' judged by a panel of three (3) accredited judges.

#### **Competition awards**

- 1. The three highest scoring images within each subject will be awarded a First, Second, Third by the judges.
- 2. From the seven 'First placed' images a "Champion Image" will be declared by the judges.
- 3. At the end of the day the scores of each image and club will be tallied. The club which has received the highest aggregate score will be declared the winning club for 2022 and will hold the Interclub trophy until next year's competition.



### **Digital format**

- 1. This is a digital image competition.
- 2. Images must be no larger than 1920 x 1080 pixels, be in sRGB colour space, be jpeg format and be less than 2MB in size.
- 3. Images may not display a watermark nor image maker identifying marks.

## 2022 Submission guidelines

- Clubs should submit their entries via the Google form: https://forms.gle/saxjh4GCZZz2NURd9
   (paste this link into your browser).
- 2. There is a fee of \$20 per club to enter this competition. This fee is to help cover the cost of judges' time and travel. Payment should be made as follows:

Payment to the BCG Westpac account. Please add "Interclub" and your camera club name to your transfer.

- 3. The person uploading your clubs' entries will need a Google email. You won't be able to complete the upload without one.
- 4. One representative from each club is to upload their club's images, making note of the following:
  - a) Submit your club entries all at one time. If you need to change something in your submission please email us at <a href="mailto:gldinterclub@gmail.com">gldinterclub@gmail.com</a> and we'll be able help.
  - b) The maximum title length is 35 characters per image. Judges will not see the image title during the judging process. The title of the image must be the same as the uploaded image file name.
    - i.e. If you upload an image called Gray Geese.jpg then your image title on the form must be Gray Geese. If you upload an image called S102584.jpg then your image title on the form is S102584.jpg
- 5. Once the images are received we'll email you to confirm we've received them. Please allow up to 48 hours for the confirmation email to arrive. The email will be sent to the email address you have used on the form.
